

Final Round of the 2024 CTTA Summer Series Trials Event at Emma Long Motorcycle Area

The final round of the 2024 CTTA Mototrials Summer Series is the **Toy Ride** at the Emma Long Motorcycle Area in Emma Long City Park in Austin. This year the series consisted of 8 rounds of trials competition. Neil King is our trial master laying out 7 sections with 3 loops. This event is benefiting the Texas Baptist Children's Home. They take in young kids no questions asked whose parents had abandoned them or are orphaned. Often the situation is both parents are in jail and have no one to take care of them. The CTTA is absorbing all costs to rent the park, AMA sanctioning and insurance so that the entry fee is your donation which 100% goes to kids in a tough spot. I'll send out a list of need items to help folks with picking up an appropriate gift. **After the event, we will be presenting the series trophies and hosting a pitch-in lunch.** We'll furnish the meat, plates, plastic ware, etc. Please bring a side dish, your own beverages, and chair. Plan to hang out with us after and goof around.

Directions: From the intersection of Highways 2222 and 360 in NW Austin

- Go West on 2222 to City Park Rd (there's a traffic light at this intersection.) Turn left (South) on City Park Rd. Go (South) for several (4+)miles to Oak Shores Dr. Turn left (East) on Oak Shores Dr and drive about a mile - the entrance to the motorcycle trail parking area is on the left. If you find yourself at the intersection of Oak Shores and Pearce Rd – you went too far!
